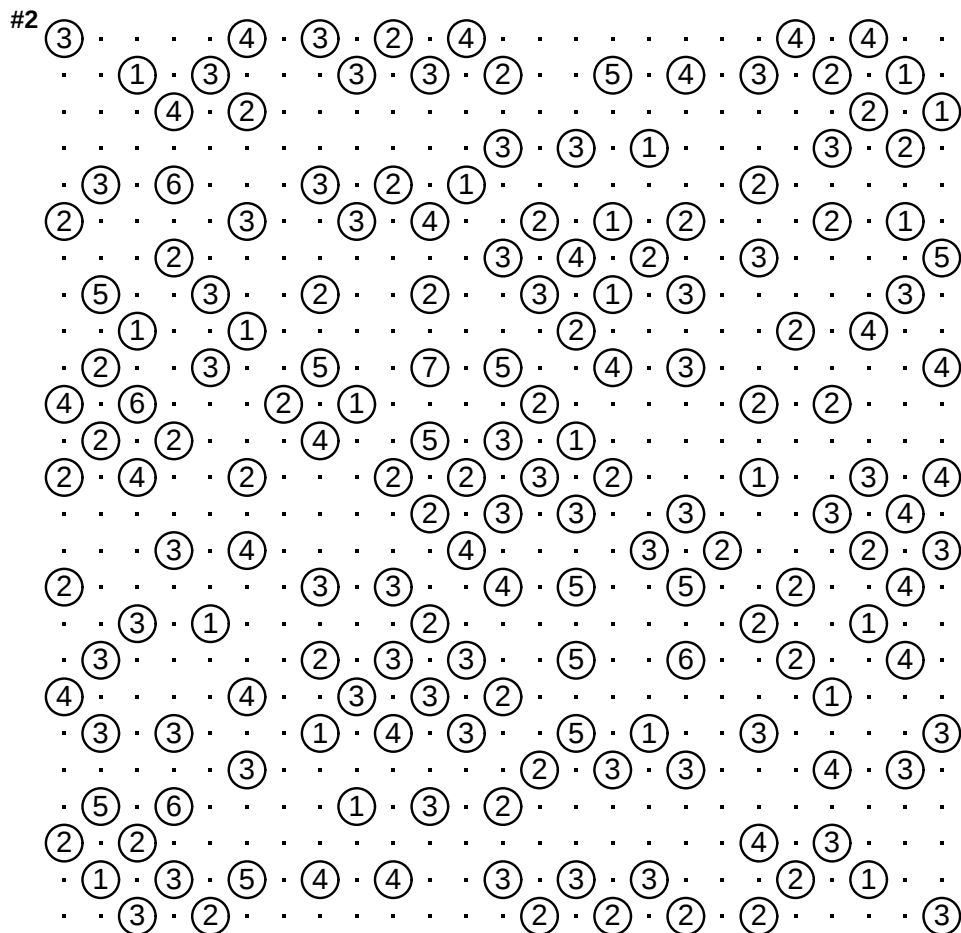
A 20x20 grid of numbers 1 through 6, arranged in a pattern that corresponds to a 6x6 hexagram magic square. The grid is composed of 20 rows and 20 columns.
