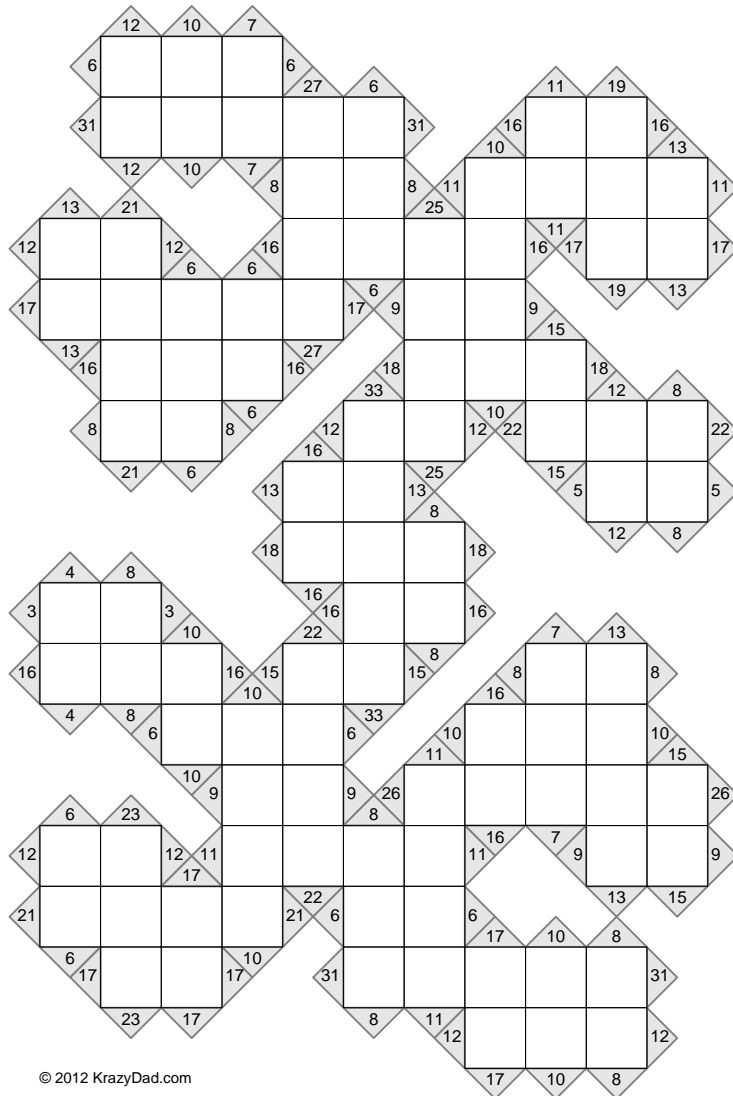


Kakuro #1
