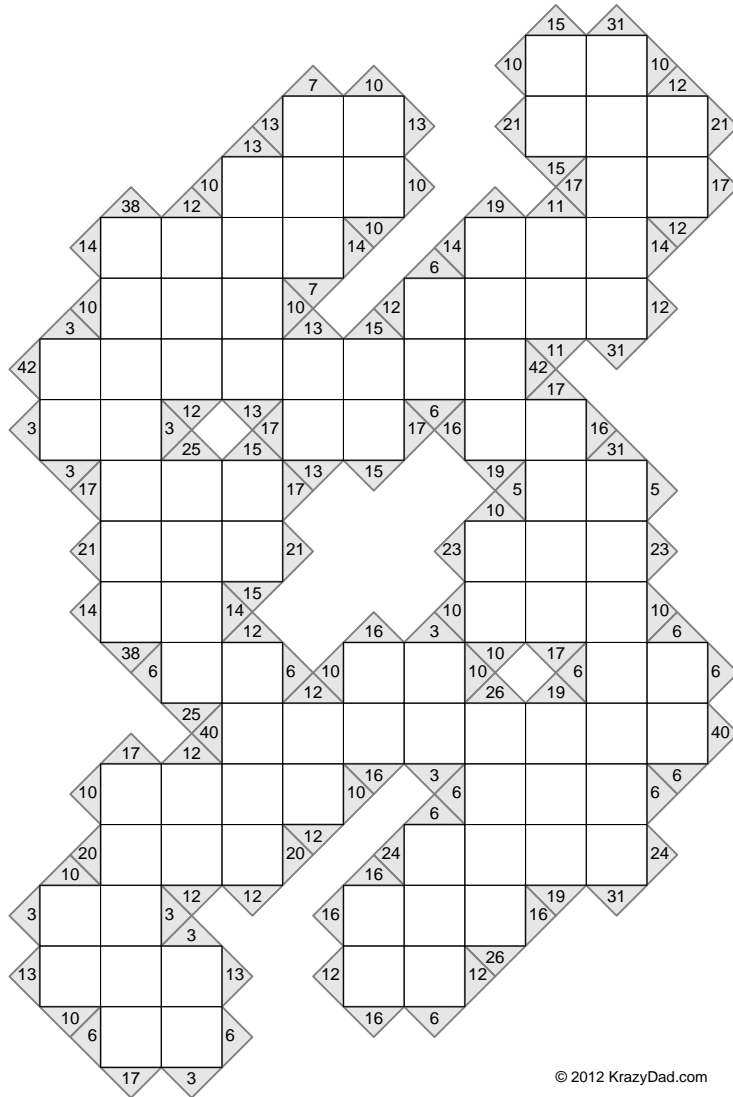


Kakuro #2
