- Top row: 15, 17, 23
- Row 2: 18 (left), 18 (right), 27 (right)
- Row 3: 25 (left), 25 (right), 9 (right)
- Row 4: 14 (left), 17 (center), 14 (center), 24 (center), 19 (center), 24 (right)
- Row 5: 9 (left), 23 (center), 9 (center), 4 (center), 4 (right)
- Row 6: 10 (left), 12 (left), 9 (right), 12 (right)
- Row 7: 15 (left), 24 (left), 24 (right)
- Bottom row: 19, 10, 27






